The Preamble to the Bill of Rights says that "In order to prevent the misconstruction or abuse of powers, further restrictive and declaratory clauses shall be added". So it says outright in the Constitution that government powers of all three branches cannot be abused. The Congress cannot misconstrue powers under article 1 section 8 and the bill of rights limits the Congress from doing so.
